The principal rules of this Workgroup are:

1.- The Workgroup in Nurses, Technicians and Related Activities is a dependence of SIS and interacts with the Board of Directors through the SIS Executive Director.

2.- This Workgroup will be Chaired by Nurse Mrs. Ana Arbona, as was approved by the Board of Directors.

3.- The Chairwoman could establish three different Sections, each of them assigned to the following areas:

The Chairwoman will communicate the names of the candidates for further confirmation of the Board of Directors.

Those materials should be delivered to the SIS Website Executive Director – Dr. Carlos Garbino- whom would coordinate with the Webmaster to define the inclusion in the Website of the information received.

6.- Objectives: study and diffusion of the related aspects of Breast Diseases that concerns Nursing, Technicians and Related activities, in their widest conception, in concordance with the main SIS Objectives established in the SIS By-Laws.

7.- Participation in scientific, educational and teaching events will be other relevant objective of this Workgroup, in particular when organized by SIS and its International School of Senology.

8.- Whom would occupy the Chair of this Workgroup has the responsibility of the programming , direction and supervision of the activities that would be performed by this Group. If necessary, will organize different Committees for developing specific areas of research and of scientific development in order to obtain different goals related to the Workgroup objectives.

9.- Any problem that could arouse outside this rules, should be reported to the SIS Executive Director that would proceed with the Board of Directors or according to their resolutions.-
